Adult Participants set an example for the young people who are participating in the **INTENSE** conference. The following guidelines are to be followed by all adults present at the conference:

• Adult Participants should be age 21 and up.

- There is no toleration of the possession of or use of illegal drugs or weapons of any kind.

- · Adult Participants are asked to assist in enforcing tent curfew and keeping noise to a minimum in the sleeping areas.

- Chaperone to youth minimum ratio is 1 adult: 8 youth
 Youth Participants assigned to you should have your cell phone number in case of an emergency.
 Chaperones should review the Code of Conduct and related guidelines with the youth in their small group.
 Chaperones are encouraged to participate in small group discussions; however, please remember to allow youth ample time to share.
 Find time during the conference to check in with your youth individually, asking what they have learned and answer questions they may have.
 Chaperones should check that their youth are acting in a mature & respectful manner at times of prayer, presentations, Mass
